We are currently seeking a dedicated Group Home Manager to oversee and manage a safe, person-centered, and enriching residential program. This position ensures the well-being, growth, and independence of individuals served, while also promoting staff competence, recreational opportunities, and quality healthcare

Key Responsibilities:

The Group Home Manager will:

- Operate a residential program that upholds consumer welfare and promotes independence and growth.
- Arrange coverage for open staff hours using the agency-approved Per-Diem list.
- Supervise program transportation arrangements and vehicle repairs; provide transportation as needed

Oversee health and psychological appointments for consumers and ensure quality care follow-up.

• Collaborate with Program Support Services to develop and implement Individualized Habilitation Plans (IHPs), behavior plans, and medical assessments



(physical, speech, and occupational therapies).

- Submit necessary reports, records, and materials to the Director of Community Support Services and the Division of Developmental Disabilities (DDD).
- Maintain and monitor behavior plan data collection and progress.
- Build a positive, respectful rapport with consumers to foster a supportive environment.
- Manage consumer funds, petty cash, and household accounts responsibly.
- Involve consumers in community events and activities, fostering engagement and inclusion.
- Maintain a programmatic calendar aligned with consumer interests and community resources.
- Act as a liaison with parents/guardians, providing support and guidance to help them navigate their family member's developmental disabilities.
- Coordinate and lead regular staff meetings to review programmatic issues, consumer progress, training, and administrative matters.
- Supervise and monitor medication administration, ensuring documentation accuracy and compliance with safety protocols.
- Train, retrain, supervise, and evaluate all staff assigned to the program
- Perform other duties as assigned to enhance the after-care experience.
- Cooperate with licensee and Division staff in any inspection or investigation.
- Follow all Arc/Morris and DDD policies, procedures, and guidelines.
- Attend mandatory trainings.

Requirements

- Ability to manage multiple priorities and responsibilities while maintaining a positive and professional demeanor.
- Excellent communication and organizational skills to coordinate with staff,



consumers, and families effectively.

- Knowledge of DDD regulations and licensing standards is a plus.
- Commitment to creating an inclusive and empowering environment for individuals

with developmental disabilities
