Position Overview

The Day Habilitation Program Supervisor oversees daily operations of the program, ensuring quality care, staff leadership, and meaningful engagement for participants. This role reports to the Director of Day Habilitation & Recreation and is responsible for staff supervision, program planning, compliance, and communication with families and guardians.

Key Responsibilities

- Supervise program operations, staffing, transportation, and consumer activities.
- Oversee consumer health appointments and ensure timely follow-up.
- Support the development and implementation of Individual Habilitation Plans (IHPs), Behavior Plans, and medical assessments.
- Manage program records, reports, and data collection.
- Ensure accurate medication administration and documentation.
- Supervise, train, and evaluate staff, coordinating regular staff meetings.
- Maintain program budget, petty cash, and consumer funds.
- Ensure facility safety, inventory, and cleanliness.
- Act as liaison with families/guardians and promote community involvement.
- Participate in inspections, audits, and quality assurance reviews.

Qualifications

- Associate's degree in Human Services + 1 year experience with adults with developmental disabilities, OR 2 years of experience with at least 1 year in a supervisory role.
- Valid driver's license (required).
- Completion of agency-required trainings within 3 months (Orientation, Developmental Disabilities Overview, Abuse/Neglect, First Aid/CPR, Medication Administration, IHP, Crisis Management).
- Strong organizational, leadership, and communication skills.
