JOB DESCRIPTION

ArcMorris is seeking a Licensed Practical Nurse (LPN) for our Residential and Day Habilitation programs.

The LPN provides direct health and specialized personal care, and related services, for consumers at all Arc/Morris programs, in accordance with an established health or care plan. In addition, the LPN provides health and specialized personal care, related education and training to staff and consumers.

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Provide healthcare to consumers, includes tube feedings, oral or nasal suctioning, characterizations (bladder, supra-pubic), and IM, IV medication administration
- Maintain daily written documentation associated with the provision of health care to consumers
- Prepare specialized personal care assessments and document personal care procedures
- Implement and assist staff in providing in specialized personal care procedures
- Participate in ISP and other meetings as required
- Supplements the nursing care needs of the patient as provided by the RN and as specified in the plan of care
- Providing services in accordance with organizations policies and procedures and regulations that define scope of practice



- Maintain active communication with families/guardians and group homes regarding health care issues
- Prepares clinical and progress notes documenting outcomes of interventions
- Prepares equipment and materials as needed according to agency policy
- Provides follow-up visits which meet patient needs and conform to physician ordered frequency
- Assists the patient in learning appropriate self-care techniques
- Evaluate patient/family response to care
- Ensures communication of information to appropriate team members
- Prepare monthly Medication Administration Records (MARs)
- Routinely review medication administration
- Provide feedback to the Program Supervisor and staff training as needed
- Site visits to ARC Morris facilities as needed
- Provide staff training as needed
- Other related tasks as assigned

REQUIREMENTS

- Valid New Jersey LPN license
- Minimum of one year related work experience in a healthcare setting required
- Clinical skills: documentation of care, medication administration, infection control precautions, assessing patient educational needs, physical assessment, obtaining vital signs, care coordination
- Excellent time management skills and ability to multitask and prioritize work
- Excellent written and verbal communication skills
- Experience in a Non-Profit Organization *a plus*
- Valid New Jersey Drivers License, with less than 5 points
